

Installation Guide for the TJ Steering Box Skid Plate Kit Part #004627400(SBSPT)



Fits TJ Wranglers '97-current

- 1. Remove the driver side lower bumper bolt, and the front lower steering box bolt.
- 2. Place the skid plate in place, positioning it over the two bolt holes now exposed.
- 3. With the skid plate positioned correctly, replace the bumper bolt, and steering box bolt.
- 4. Use flat washers to correct the spacing of skid plate when using stock bumper.
- 7. With the skid plate in place, locate the remaining hole in the ear of the skid plate. Using the hole as a guide, use a center punch to mark the location on the round cross member.
- 8. Use a 5/16" drill bit to drill the location you just marked on the cross member.
- 9. With the supplied self-tapping bolt, secure the final corner of the skid plate to the cross member.
